

Call for scholar scholarships

European Master in the Psychology of Global Mobility, Inclusion and Diversity in Society (Global-MINDS)

Global-MINDS welcomes inspiring and outstanding guest scholars who are interested in contributing to the Global-MINDS master programme and strengthening academic partnerships with the consortium.

Global-MINDS is a comprehensive 2-year study programme focusing on insights from Social and Cultural Psychology and applying them to contemporary societal issues. Students receive a thorough education in social and cultural psychological theory, research and methods, as well as training in intercultural skills – assets that are indispensable in today's global knowledge economy and multicultural working environments.

Universities from five countries jointly deliver the Global-MINDS programme in English:

- ISCTE – Lisbon University Institute (ISCTE-IUL), Lisbon, Portugal
- Koç University (KU), Istanbul, Turkey
- University of Limerick (UL), Limerick, Ireland
- University of Oslo (UiO), Oslo, Norway
- University of Social Sciences and Humanities (SWPS), Warsaw, Poland

Candidate profile

Global-MINDS welcomes scholars holding a PhD degree and with an expertise in ***Culture, Human Behaviour and Health*** to contribute to the course **Cultural Determinants of Human Behaviour at SWPS University of Social Science and Humanities, Warsaw, Poland for a period of 2 weeks, between 1-13 October, 2019.**

Scholars are selected on their academic merit (e.g. publications, research projects) and what they can bring to the joint Master's programme. The Global-MINDS team may schedule an interview through video conferencing with applicants.

Erasmus Mundus Scholar Scholarships

Guest scholars shall be awarded an Erasmus Mundus Scholar Mobility scholarship which includes:

- 1) a Weekly Stipend of 1.200€ (exempt from income tax)
- 2) a flat travel allowance of 500€ for EU residents and 1000€ for non-EU residents; and
- 3) either hotel housing organized by the host institution or a housing allowance of 500€ per week.

Scholar activities

The guest scholar's contribution will consist of teaching up to 15 contact hours, plus associated activities, focusing on the topic *Culture, Human Behaviour, and Health*.

The teaching activities include:

- preparing and delivering teaching materials on Culture and Human Behaviour (the exact topics can be discussed with the Global-MINDS coordinators at SWPS);
- collaborating, creating and correcting assignments and assessments during and/or after their visit;
- contributing to the promotion and dissemination of Global-MINDS in their own institution and country of origin after their visiting scholar activities.

Deadline

The application deadline is 30th of April, 2019.
